Monday, January 22, 2024

Due to inclement weather, The Florissant City Council met in a virtual meeting through a Zoom platform on Monday, January 22, 2024 at 7:00 PM with Council President Eagan presiding.

#### I. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

The Chair asked everyone in attendance to stand and join in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

A quorum being present the Chair stated that the Council Meeting was in session for the transaction of business.

The City Clerk reported that Public Hearing 24-01-004 for the Request to amend the Zoning Code to add "Tobacco Store" as a Special Use to Sections 405.115, 405.120, 405.125, 405.130, and 405.460. The Chair declared the Public Hearing to be open.

Patrick Mulcahy, Economic Development Director, noted one of the purposes of the Comprehensive Plan was to give the city actionable items to change. One actionable item was to diversify businesses within Florissant. Mr. Mulcahy noted creating a special use and limiting the number of tobacco stores, like liquor stores, will allow the city to track the number of stores and diversify businesses within the city. He noted this will help the city to not be oversaturated with tobacco stores and protect public health and the environment. Mr. Mulcahy noted this would not affect current store locations, it would only effect if a tobacco store would close and a new one would open, however no stores in the city are non-conforming to the proposed ordinance.

WHEREA

The Block History Month 2024 theme, "African Americans and the Arts," explores the key influence African Americans have had in the fields of "visual and performing arts, literature, fashion, folklore, language, film, music exchitecture, culinary and other forms of cultural expression.; and

WHEREAS:

We sale rate by shining a light on visual and performing arts, literature, fashion, folklore, language, film, masic, architecture, culinary and other forms of cultural expression in which the African American influence has been paramount; and

WHEREAS:

African American artists have used art to presenve bistory and community memory as well as for empowerment, artistic and cultural movements such as the New Negro, Black Arts, Black Renaissance, Hip-Hop and Afrofuturism, have been led by people of African descent and set the standard for popular trends around the world; and

WHEREAS:

Blues musicians such as Robert Johnson, McKinley 'Muddy Waters' Morganfield and Riley "BB" B. King created and nurtured a style of music that became the bedrock for gospel, soul, rock and roll and other still popular (and evolving) forms of music, including hip-hop which continues to be a pivotal force in political, social, and cultural spaces, lifting up issues such as racial violence, sexism, economic disinvestment; and

WHEREAS:

Black contributions to literature include works by poets like Phillis Wheatley, essays, autobiographies, and novels by writers such as David Walker, Maria Stewart and Octavia Butler. Black aesthetics have also manifested themselves through sculptors like Edmonia Lewis and Wangechi Mutu and painters like Henry O. Tanner and Lina Iris Viktor; and

WHEREAS:

Today and every day, we celebrate African Americans and the Arts, and encourage all people to recognize and confront systemic racism in our neighborhoods and the wider community by standing in the gap at every opportunity, bridging barriers with fearlessness and determination to fight against racism and bigotry and improve representation of Black people, not only in the arts. but all facets of our society.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Timothy J. Lowery, MAYOR OF THE CITY OFFLORISSANT, MISSOURI and Members of the City Council hereby proclaim the month of February 2024 as Black History Month in the City of Florissant, and calls upon all citizens, public officials, and educators to observe this month with appropriate programs, ceremonies, and activities.

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A TRANSFER OF SPECIAL USE NO. 7784 FROM J&J PIZZA, LLC D/B/A PAPA JOHNS PIZZA TO BAJCO ILLINOIS, LLC D/B/A PAPA JOHNS PIZZA LOCATED AT 12735 NEW HALLS FERRY RD FOR THE OPERATION OF A RESTAURANT.

WHEREAS, the Florissant Zoning Ordinance authorizes the Council of the City of Florissant, by Special Use Permit, after public hearing thereon, to permit the location of a Restaurant; and

WHEREAS J&J Pizza, LLC d/b/a Papa Johns Pizza was issued Special Use Permit no. 7784 for the operation of a restaurant located at 12735 New Halls Ferry Road; and

WHEREAS Bajco Illinois, LLC d/b/a Papa Johns Pizza has filed an application to transfer Special use Permit no. 7784 authorizing the location and operation of a restaurant located at 12735 New Halls Ferry Road to its name; and

WHEREAS the City Council of the City of Florissant determined at its meeting on January 22, 2024 that the business would be operated in substantially identical fashion as set out herein; and

WHEREAS Bajco Illinois, LLC d/b/a Papa Johns Pizza has accepted the terms and conditions as they apply to a special use permit for a restaurant.

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLORISSANT, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Special Use Permit no. 7784 is hereby transferred from rom J&J Pizza, LLC d/b/a Papa Johns Pizza to Bajco Illinois, LLC d/b/a Papa Johns Pizza located at 12735 New Halls Ferry Rd for the operation of a restaurant.

Section 2: Said Permit herein authorized shall remain in full force and effect and subject to all of the ordinances of the City of Florissant.

The following Lease Agreement has been entered into on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of December, 2023 between Cameron and Jamie Lewis (Lessor) and Chris Timmerman and Nick Boyd of Big Belly Deli

The following terms have been agreed upon by both parties and both parties agree to uphold their end of the lease.

- The building space at 392 St. Ferdinand, Florissant, Missouri contains approximately 2475 square feet.
  - Big Belly Deli will maintain occupancy of all 2475 minus the following areas that will be occupied by Cameron and Jamie Lewis of Helfer's Pastries
    - i. 21 sq. ft in front prep area where current coffee supplies are.
    - ii. 81 sq. ft. of storage space in storage room. Helfer's Pastries will occupy the right side of the room that is split down the middle
    - 145 sq. ft. of upstairs office space that is currently the far left wall of the upstairs office space
  - Dining room space will continue to be shared between patrons of Helfer's Pastries and Big Belly Deli
  - Two restrooms located inside of 392 St. Ferdinand Street will be accessible to both Helfer's Pastries and Big Belly Deli patrons
- The said premises should be used for the sole purpose of retail deli and food only and for no other purpose without the written consent of the Lessor
- 3. The term of this lease shall commence on the 1st day of December, 2023 and will extend through the 30th day of November, 2024
- 4. Lessee shall pay rent in the sum of \$1430.00 for the first three months (December 2023, January 2023, February 2024). After month three, rent will increase \$250/month for the following four months.
  - a. March 2024-\$1680
  - b. April 2024- \$1930
  - c. May 2024- \$2180
  - d. June 2024-\$2450
  - e. Starting in July 2024, rent will continue and maintain at \$2450/month for the remainder of the lease.
- 5. Rent will be due on the first day of this lease and the same day of each following month.

- Lessor will retain a security deposit in the total amount of \$2448 over the course of four months.
  - a. As agreed by both the Lessor and Lessee, security deposit payments of \$612/month will be made in the following months- December 2023, January 2024, February 2024, March 2024.
  - b. The security deposit shall be retained by the Lessor until the termination of this lease. The security deposit will be applied towards damages to the building incurred by the Lessor. Notification of the use of the security deposit will be made by the Lessor to the Lessee in writing.

WHEREAS, the City of Florissant, MO's elected and appointed officials maintain steadfast stewardship of the public's finances by efficiently and effectively balancing revenues and expenses; and,

WHEREAS, over 27.58 percent of the City of Florissant, MO's annual revenue is generated by the taxation on the retail sale of goods and services within its boundaries; and,

WHEREAS, sales tax revenue plays a crucial role in sustaining critical local municipal services and infrastructure such as police and support staff, snow removal, recreational programs, playgrounds, summer camps, road and sidewalk repair, and more; and,

WHEREAS, approximately \$4.4 million dollars in annual sales tax revenue in the City of Florissant, MO is collected from the imposition of sales tax on food items; and,
